

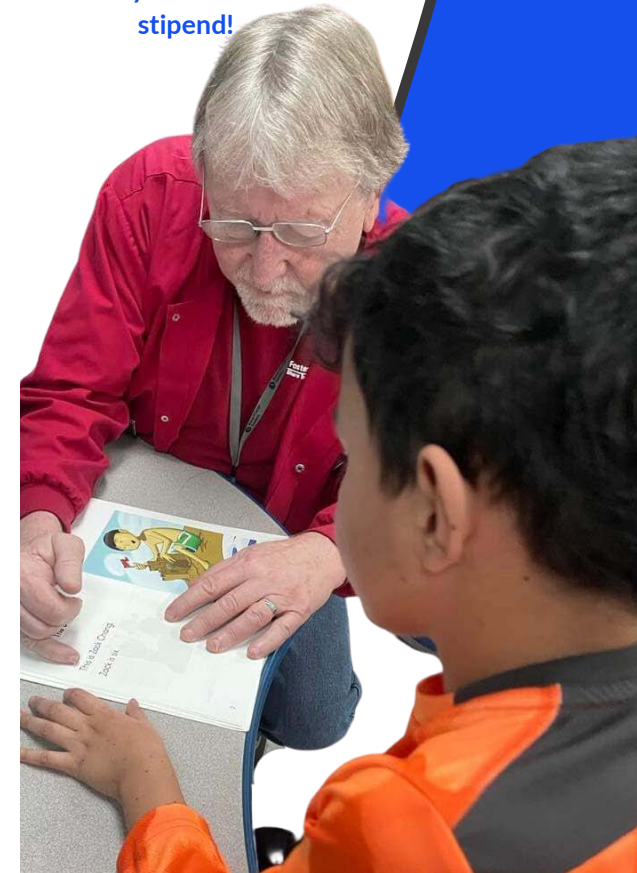

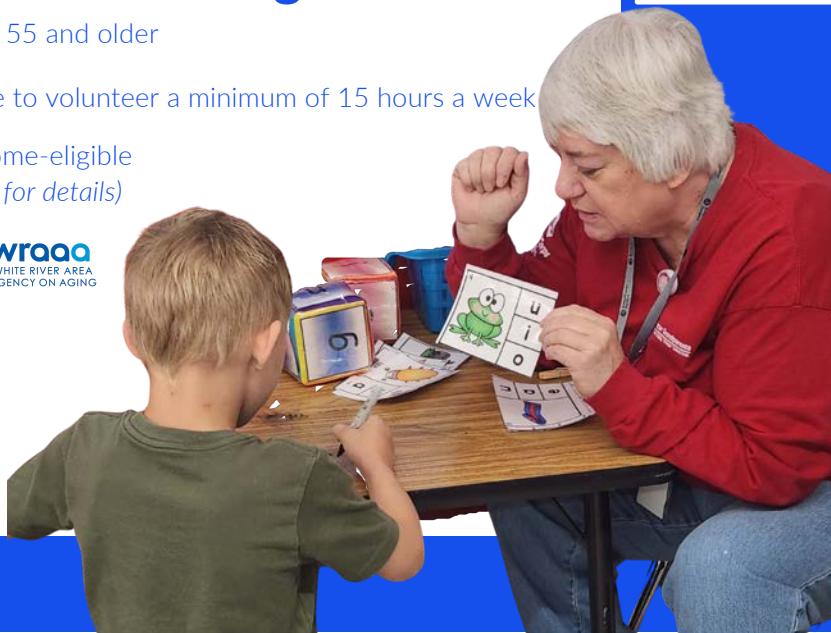


What is the **Foster Grandparent Program?**

As an **AmeriCorps Senior** grantee, WRAAA recruits Foster Grandparent volunteers to be role models, mentors, and friends to children. The program empowers volunteers age 55 and over to be active in their community by serving children and youth. AmeriCorps Seniors volunteer at schools, Head Start programs, after-school programs, or day care centers to support youth in their educational or developmental needs.

Who is **Eligible?**

- Age 55 and older
- Able to volunteer a minimum of 15 hours a week
- Income-eligible
